#### Wembdon Fireworks Display - 26th October 2024

The Grand Fireworks Display staged by the WCA certainly went with a bang in the early evening of Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> October 2024. We cannot remember a time when the weather conditions were so good to us. In dry, clear weather the WCA Committee members worked all afternoon with "Skyburst The Fireworks Company" to prepare the field for the professionally fired display.



The fireworks were prepared, barriers measured, collected and erected, refreshment tent prepared, and generator and lighting installed in time for the early arrivals. The Skyburst Team worked hard at the far edge of the field preparing the £3000 display. Although slightly soggy underfoot the community flocked in to witness the display, which proved even more spectacular and lasted longer than in previous years. As promised the display started relatively promptly which unfortunately caused a few latecomers to miss it and as usual the WCA incurred a small financial loss on the event, but after such a successful Village Day we were able to absorb the losses. Any financial loss is worthwhile if we prevented a child's injury from a home display. Thanks must go to those with pets and



livestock who heeded our many warnings of the event and to Asda and Morrison's Supermarkets for their kind sponsorships, along with all who helped in any way on the day or in the clearing of the field and cleaning up afterwards. The 2025 event will take place on the evening of Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> October.

#### SID and Community Speedwatch Report

We continue to see an increase in traffic flow through the village since work has started on the Cokerhurst development.

Vehicle movements per day have risen as follows:

Sandford Hill - from 426 per day Jan '24 to 711 per day in Oct/November

Wembdon Rise (by Wares Lane) – from 873 per day to 1,165 per day in Oct/November

Wembdon Rise (from NDR) – from 1,444 per day to 1,672 per day in Oct/November

Wembdon Hill (bus stop) - from 919 per day to 1019 per day in Sept/October

#### Average speeds and 85<sup>th</sup>% (speed most drivers travel at)

Sandford Hill – Av.26.50 mph and 34 mph (Highest speed 84 mph exiting the village @ 6 p.m. – 62 mph incoming @ 4 p.m.)!

Wembdon Rise (by Wares Lane) - Av. 20.71 mph & 24 mph (Highest speed 59 mph @ 06:30 a.m.).

Wembdon Rise (from NDR) - Av. 20.86 mph & 25 mph (Highest speed 65 mph @ 8 p.m.)

Wembdon Hill (bus stop heading East) – 21.3 mph & 26.6 mph (Highest speed 45 mph @ 7.20 p.m.)

These have remained broadly unchanged over the past year.

#### **COMMUNITY SPEEDWATCH**

Our co-ordinator recently attended a meeting at Bridgwater police station which was called by Chief Insp Stephanie McKenna. He raised several issues which affect Wembdon CSW (many appear common to other schemes).

We have been instructed on revised procedures for reporting any verbal abuse (which cannot be resolved by the team) using 101 & on-line forms (backed-up by reporting on the SWAN database). Again, they have stressed the importance of using "WHAT 3 WORDS" if requesting urgent police support.

We have been instructed to record MOT & Tax anomalies (from DVLA check) which is a 100% U-Turn from previous advice. SID data sent to A&S police is not viewed (due to the sheer volume of data they recieve). Speed enforcement report that there are NO suitable sites for a van or tripod enforcement within our 20mph area (M/Cycles are being phased out). However, they have promised they will look again at this. We have been instructed that the use of private video / photo recording is ENCOURAGED and particularly to support reports of verbal abuse. Pocket speed devices (ours) are being phased out & will be replaced with different units as they are gradually replaced. A&S have brand new enforcement vans including 2 x unmarked vans which have AI technology which can detect various moving traffic offences as well as speeders.

#### **Allotment News**



As the winter approaches the allotments are being prepared for the winter's rest. There are crops which will over winter, garlic, onion sets, broad beans, leeks, brussels sprouts, parsnips are some. Many allotment holders cover over their plots with weed suppressant material to reduce the effect of the weather on the soil and prevent weeds from continuing to grow. This method has the added bonus of keeping the soil a little bit warmer, enabling earlier sowing of seeds in the spring.

Some allotment holders relinquishing their plots because of ill health or change of circumstances preventing them for spending the time they would like to get the most out of the plots. Regrettably the elder statesman of allotment holders, at the age of 90 years young, relinquished his plot after over 30 years this autumn. He will be sorely missed by his allotment neighbours. #### Overgrowing vegetation – what a nuisance!

You decide to take a Sunday afternoon walk around the streets of Wembdon and what do you often find? Brambles overhanging a footpath! If you see them, you can duck out of the way, but if not you get a nasty scratch on your head. Then you find that someone has allowed their hedge to grow out over the pavement. A mother pushing a pushchair steps out into the road because the width of the pavement has been reduced by the hedge and is narrowly missed by a car. Suddenly your pleasant stroll isn't quite so enjoyable.

Who is to blame for this. Somerset Council? Wembdon Parish Council? Keir Starmer? No. It is the adjacent landowner.

Section 154 of the Highways Act 1960 gives Local Authorities the power to require landowners to cut back vegetation growing on their land which is overhanging the highway or footpath. This means that Somerset Council would write saying that if the work is not carried out in a reasonable time, then they will do it and charge the landowner. In Wembdon, the Parish Clerk often writes to the person responsible asking politely for the work to be done, or the matter will be reported to Somerset Council.

Is all this timewasting bureaucracy really necessary? Surely everyone who owns a garden or field next to a footpath would have the common sense not to let vegetation grow out and cause a nuisance to others? Sadly, not everyone takes their responsibilities as a landowner and member of the community seriously.

Please do not let this be you. If you have a hedge, tree or bush then please don't let it spoil my walk on a Sunday afternoon.

I had better pop into the Cottage Inn now to calm down!
